Post - Foundation Coach

1. Reporting to and working with the Outreach Officer. The Foundation Coach is responsible for delivering the Foundation's Doorstep Club programme in Youth Clubs in Bath and the surrounding areas. The Doorstep Club programme is aimed at engaging hard to reach young people living in deprived areas and uses sport as the key to delivering personal and social development messages. It is a multisport programme which focusses on a combination of sports and is delivered in a fun and welcoming environment. At the end of each term there are opportunities to take the young people on a range of events and activities which are organised by the Outreach Officer.

Programme/ Project Delivery

2. Help plan and deliver the Doorstep Club programme to recipients in Youth Clubs and other community settings to the required quality standards.
3. Help to foster, maintain and strengthen Bath Rugby Foundation partnerships and relationships with recipients of the programmes, key sponsors and stakeholders.
4. To ensure that a safe environment is maintained for all.
5. To work alongside other Bath Rugby Foundation staff and apprentices to deliver the sessions.
